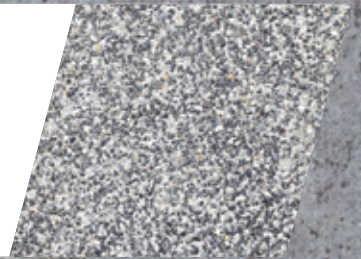

Finishes

Markstone Landscaping offers four kinds of concrete finishes: **Brushed** concrete, **Exposed** concrete, **Stamped** concrete and **Modern** (or limestone finish) concrete.

2. Choose your colours.

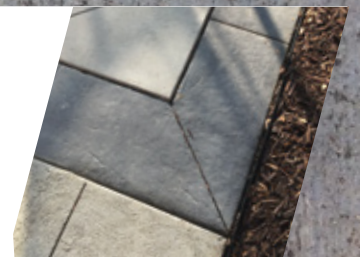
Most concrete projects use the natural colour of concrete, however, if you'd like to add colour to project you can choose from our **integral colour** or **colour hardener** colour palettes.



Borders & Cuts

3. Choose your borders and cuts.

The final step to complete your project is to decide on borders and cuts. We offer **square**, **diamond** or **custom** cuts, as well as **trowel** or **stamped** borders.

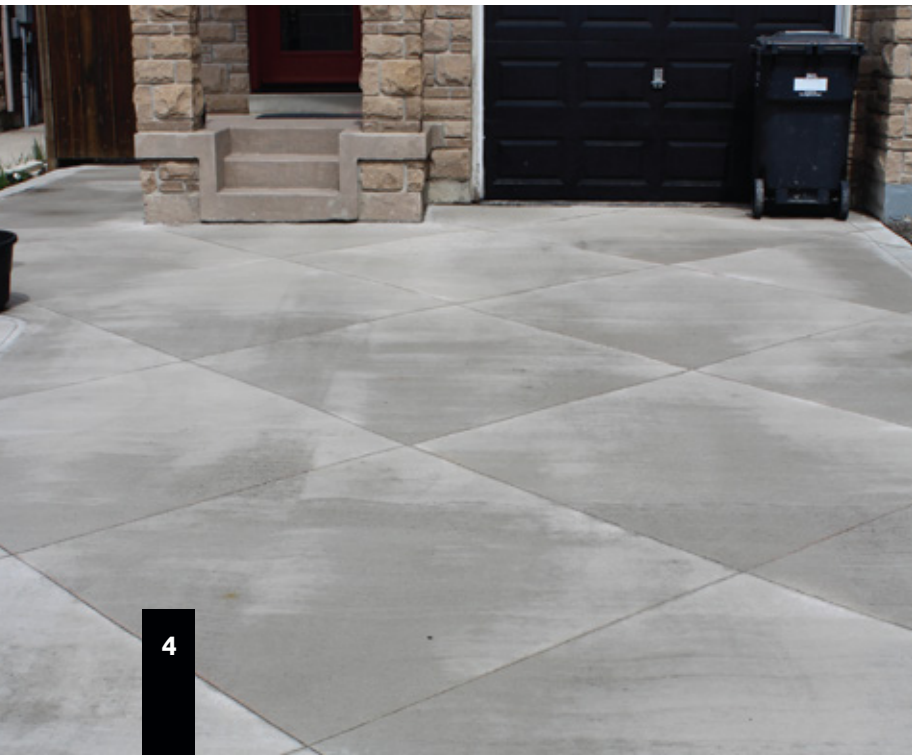
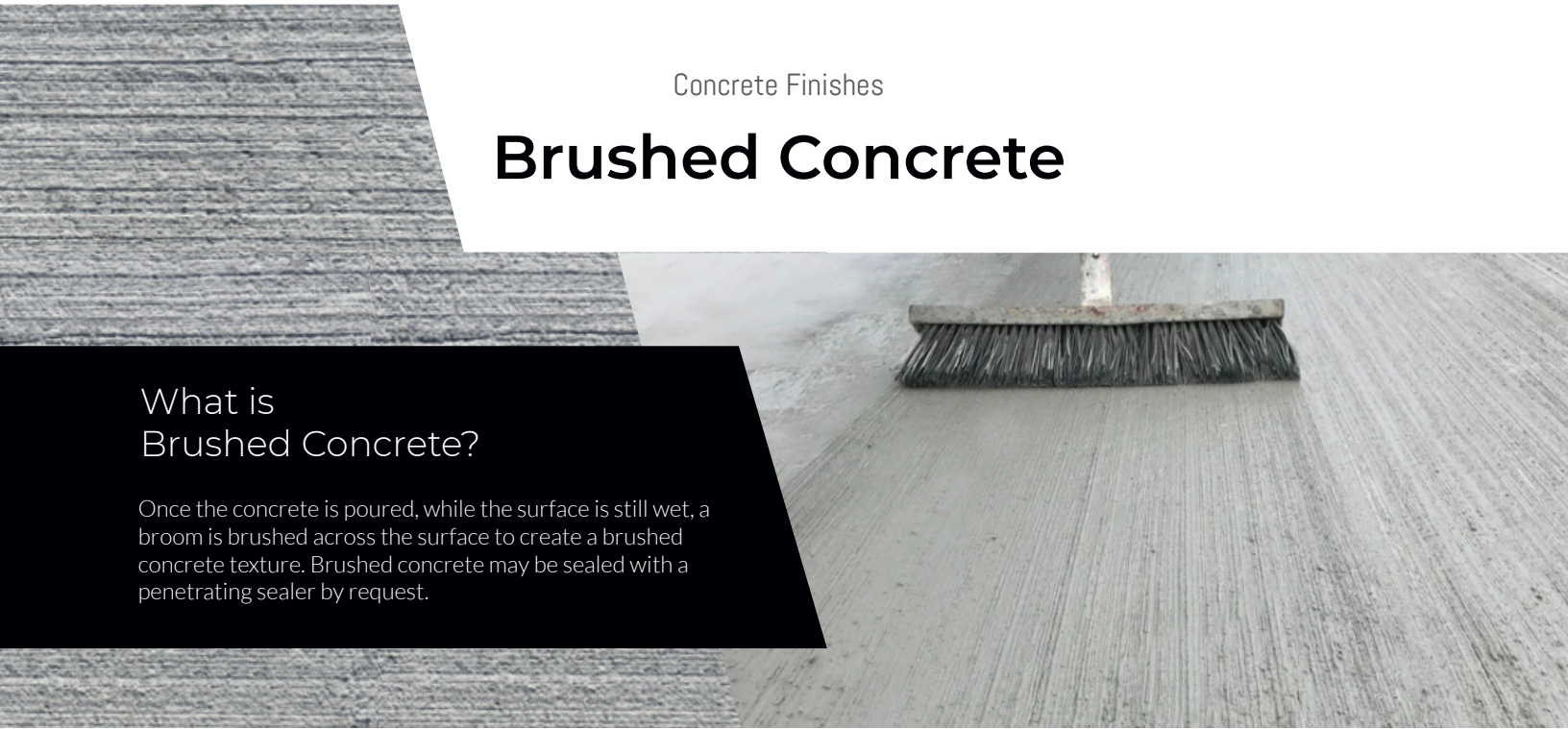


Concrete Finishes

Brushed Concrete

What is Brushed Concrete?

Once the concrete is poured, while the surface is still wet, a broom is brushed across the surface to create a brushed concrete texture. Brushed concrete may be sealed with a penetrating sealer by request.





Concrete Finishes

Exposed Concrete

What is Exposed Concrete?

The exposed concrete texture is achieved by adding pea gravel into the concrete mixture. Once the concrete is poured, a chemical is applied to the surface to prevent the top-most layer from curing. The next day, this top layer is washed off to expose the pea gravel texture. Exposed concrete is finished with a high gloss sealer.



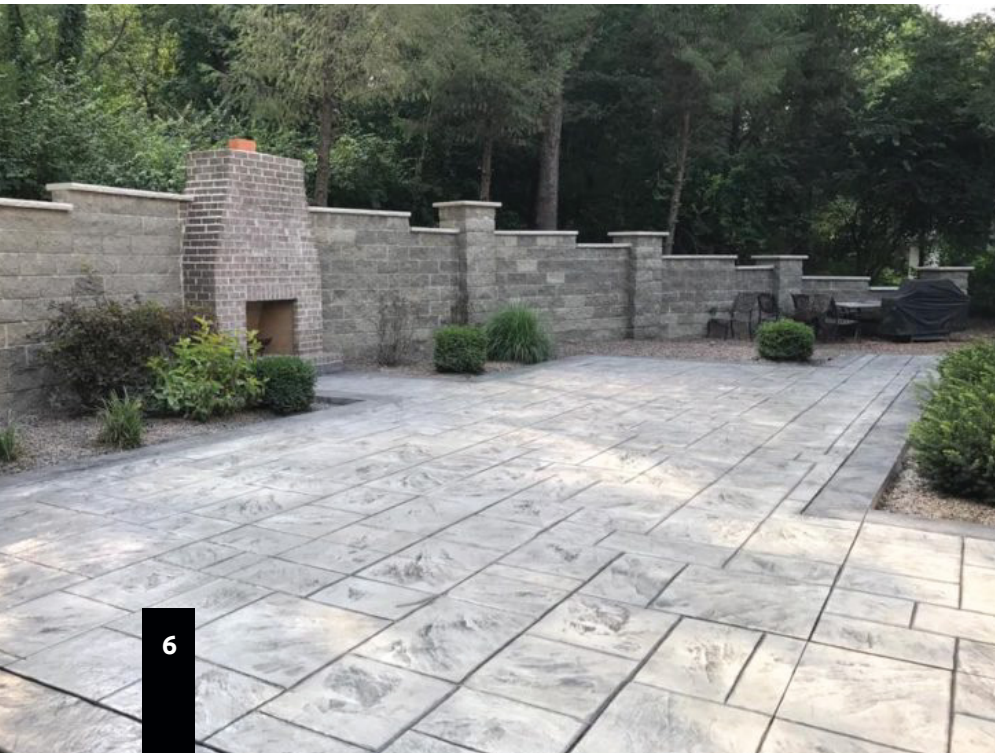
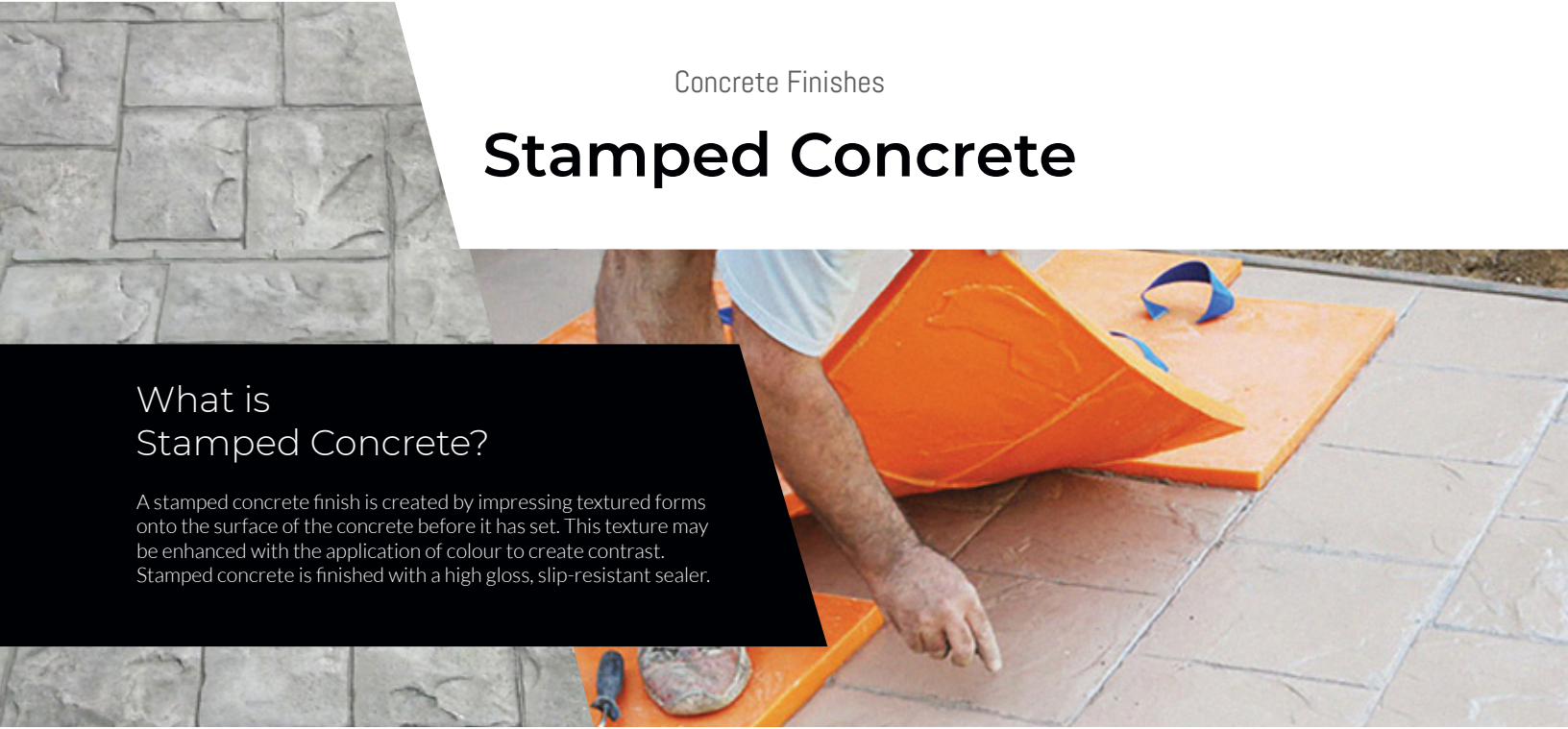


Concrete Finishes

Stamped Concrete

What is Stamped Concrete?

A stamped concrete finish is created by impressing textured forms onto the surface of the concrete before it has set. This texture may be enhanced with the application of colour to create contrast. Stamped concrete is finished with a high gloss, slip-resistant sealer.





Concrete Finishes

Modern Concrete

What is Modern Concrete?

Modern concrete is a smooth, matte finish concrete which resembles limestone. Once the concrete is poured and set, the surface is hand-polished and sandblasted. It is then finished with a penetrating sealer to provide a protective matte finish.





Concrete Colour

Colour Hardener

What is Colour Hardener?

Colour Hardener is a colored powder used to colour the surface of your concrete after it has been poured.

Final colour will vary due to natural colour of concrete. Colours are not guaranteed.
















Integral Colour



What is Integral Colour?

Integral colour is a coloured powder that is mixed into the concrete while its still in the concrete truck. This means that your concrete will be coloured all the way through as opposed to a layer of colour on the surface.

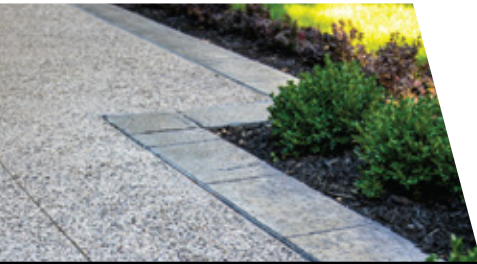

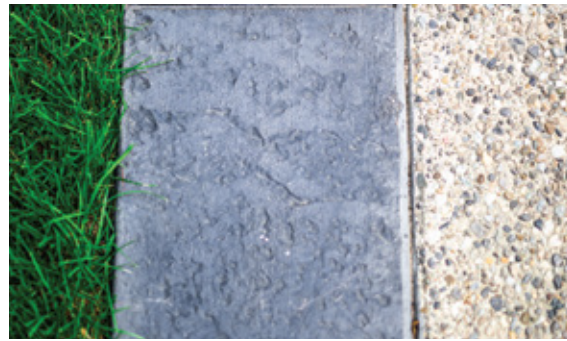


Concrete Borders

Add a finishing touch to your project by adding a border. A trowel finish border is a smooth border create with a trowel. A stamped border is created by impressing a texture into the border and finishing it with a colour hardener.



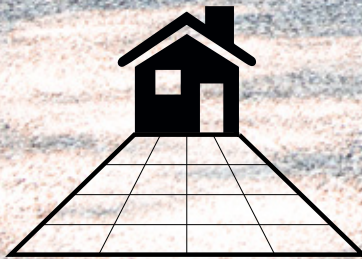
Trowel Border

Concrete cuts are more than just a decorative way to finish your project - they serve to ensure that your concrete does not crack in unsightly places.

Our Concrete Process

Markstone Landscaping prides itself on using specialized crews at every stage of your project.

1 Excavating Crew

The first crew to arrive on site will be the excavating crew. They will remove existing interlock/ concrete/ asphalt and excavate the area. This debris will then be loaded into dump trucks and hauled away.



2 Framing Crew

Next to arrive will be the framing crew. The framing crew will build the frames into which concrete will be poured.



3 Gravelling & Rebar Crew

Our gravelling and rebar crew will arrive next. This crew will lay gravel and tamp it down to create the foundation of your project. Rebar will be placed overtop of the gravel and tied to hold in place.



4 Concrete Crew

The next crew to arrive will be the concrete pouring crew accompanied by a concrete truck. This crew will install the concrete and apply the finish of your choice (brushed, exposed, stamped, modern).



5 Cleaning Crew

The final crew on site will be the cleaning crew. This crew will cut the concrete and complete the overall finished look of your project. This crew may come back a second time if your project requires sealing.





Interlock

Pavers & Slabs

1. Choose your pavers & slabs.

Interlock laid on flat surfaces such as driveways, walkways and patios is laid using pavers and slabs. **Pavers** are thick, 80mm stones used on driveways and any areas where heavy vehicles will be parked. **Slabs** are thinner, 45-60mm stones used in foot-traffic areas such as walkways and patios. Consider creating a **border** to accent your project!



Blocks & Coping

2. Choose your blocks & coping.

Blocks & copings are used to create vertical structures such as steps, garden walls and retaining walls. **Blocks** refer to the bricks which are stacked in tiers to create the height of the wall. **Copings** refer to the flat stones used to place on top of the wall. Consider using a different coloured coping to accent your wall!

Markstone Landscaping prides itself on using specialized crews at every stage of your project.

1 Excavating Crew

The first crew to arrive on site will be the excavating crew. They will remove existing interlock/ concrete/ asphalt and excavate the area. This debris will then be loaded into dump trucks and hauled away. This crew will also prepare the foundation of your project.



2 Material Delivery

Next, the interlocking stone will be delivered to your location.



3 Interlocking Crew

Once the material is on site, our interlocking crew will arrive. This crew will prepare the final grading of your project and install the interlock. They will finish by applying polymeric sand and aluminum edging.



4 Cleaning Crew

The final crew to arrive will be the cleaning crew. They will ensure that all debris has been cleared from the job site and the project is ready for you to enjoy!
